
## **Missions**—Local

# PRAYER WALK FOR OUR SCHOOLS

Sunday, August 18. Churches are asked to meet at their local school, walk the grounds and pray for students, families, teachers and administrators.

GNC are weekly Bible studies that are allowed in elementary schools across the nation. Half of the elementary schools in South Carolina have them, but only one is taking place locally. Beginning this fall, the KBA has budgeted funds for the 2019-20 school vear so we can have a GNC in every elementary school at no cost to your church. Your church will need to provide 8-10 volunteers (or combine with another church). KBA will provide all training, literature and funding for the school year. As of the end of June, many of our KCSD elementary schools are being "claimed" by our churches, but not all.
