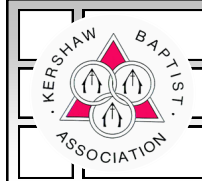

GOOD NEWS CLUB TRAINING

GNC are weekly Bible studies that are allowed in elementary schools across the nation. Half of the elementary schools in South Carolina have them, but only one is taking place locally. Beginning this fall, the KBA has budgeted funds for the 2019-20 school year so we can have a GNC in every elementary school at no cost to your church.
