

He has been serving as a long-term substitute teacher in one of our schools to earn grocery money. As this position soon ends, they want to engage the full-time ministry to which God has called them. What might you and your church be able to do to support this great work? For sure, pray for God's vision and timing to be made known. Primarily, they now need your financial support for 2021. The SC Baptist Convention has approved Silvio as a church planter, providing some support.
