One **black** non-retractable pen (no wire clips, no other ink color)

One writing tablet no larger than 5 1/2"x8" (no wire bound, composition book, or post it notes)

One adult toothbrush (individually factory-sealed, no multi-packs)

One 4-6oz toothpaste (no travel size)

One 3.2-6oz bar of soap (no travel size, no unwrapped or unboxed bars)

Two rolls of hard candy like LifeSavers, Mentos, Breath Savers (NO Smarties,

Sweetarts, Necco Wafers, Rolos, Starburst, TicTacs)

Three first-class #10 Stamp-Embossed Envelopes from US Post Office (No regular stamps, no other size envelopes) One gallon size zipper bag (no other bags accepted)

Horsham, PA Disaster Relief Story

Scripture tells us in Matthew 5:16, "to let your light so shine before men, that they might see your good works and glorify your Father in Heaven."

The Horsham, PA area had been hit with seven tornadoes which spawned

off of the hurricane Ida. It also swept through Louisiana before moving northward bringing devastation up into the northeast. At the request of PA Disaster Relief, Southern Carolina Disaster Relief agreed to provide relief to the Horsham area. This involved five weeks of work for the SCDR teams, in addition to sending teams to Louisiana. SC sent Horsham administrative teams, assessors and chaplains, food teams, laundry, shower teams, chainsaw teams, mud-out teams. Our chainsaw team was thankful for the four Godly women, from up the road in Florence, SC, who kept us well fed. September 26th, two KBA team members teamed up with six men from Summerville Baptist Church, Round Hill Baptist Church and Three Rivers Association to travel to Horsham. Our chainsaw crew went to Glorify our Father by giving assistance to storm victims with downed trees and damaged homes. In four days of work, our team helped eleven homeowners remove downed or damaged trees, some posing danger. In two cases, they were partially on roofs of the homes. Through work done with loving hands and kind words we were granted the opportunity to pray over homeowners and others. We gave each homeowner a Bible, signed by the team members. We inquired of their relationship to Jesus. We gave several gospel presentations. One gentleman accepted the Lord as his personal Lord and Savior. Another lady said she was "moving in that direction". We were working on a downed tree when the homeowner was gone. The neighbor next door brought us cold tea. Then later invited us into her home for coffee during a chilling rainstorm. As if that wasn't enough, she then bought our team pizza for lunch. Sherri, wrote, "You men have been the topic of my conversation at the salon [her work place] because you all have so much kindness and willingness, it was a pleasure to be witness to it. I am so elated to have had the pleasure of your company and to have met all of you. I love the compact Bible and the kind words [written in it]." God wants His People to be mission minded. Mark 12:31, says "you shall love you neighbor as yourself". Our faith in Jesus Christ motivates us to prepare to go again.
