A group of KBA Pastors and I recently met together for the day to discuss and plan future vision and ministry that will best support our Pastors and churches of our Association. I tried to listen well to their hearts and words. Here are the takeaways that I left with. 1- Large and small churches often have very different needs, so KBA ministry must be quite diverse and flexible to care for all our churches. 2- The care of our Pastors, staffs, and family's needs to continue to be a priority. 3- Networking, networking, networking! Greater opportunities for Pastors and Staff to network needs to occur. 4- Equipping of the churches needs to be an even stronger goal of the Association in coming days, addressing needs like youth and music ministry of small churches, use of technology, training of deacons and committees, and discipleship training, among others. 5- Let us continue to offer and encourage missional opportunities: local, national and international. 6- Put a greater emphasis on training for and implementing church revitalization of the smaller churches and partnering of the larger churches with the smaller ones. 7- KBA by laws need to be updated, providing less structure so to give the greatest freedom to do effective ministry in changing times. I have already begun to implement some of these recommendations. We are now scheduling Pastor/Staff gatherings in different geographical sections of the Association so they can better network. We are planning a top-notch marriage retreat for our Pastors, staff and wives in September, recently approved at our spring meeting. We are putting together a church revitalization team comprised of Pastors as well as organizing a by-laws committee. I'm looking at starting a 'Church U' (Church University) thrust in the fall that can offer all sorts of training opportunities to our churches and leaders on a regular basis. KBA, I am your suggestion box! Please contact me with feedback on these things I've shared as well as your own new (or old) ideas. 
