

It's that time of year again to start collecting the packets!! All packets are due to the KBA Mission Center by November 29th.

The approved list is as follows:

One black non-retractable pen (no wire clips, no other color ink).

One writing tablet no larger than 5 $1/2 \times 8$ (no wire bound book, no composition books, no post-it-notes).

One adult toothbrush (individually factory sealed (**no multi packs**).

One 4 to 6 oz toothpaste (**no travel size**).

One 3.2 to 6 oz bar of soap (no travel size, no unwrapped or unboxed bars).

Two rolls of hard candy like LifeSavers, Mentos, Breath Savers (Absolutely NO Smarties, Sweetarts, Necco Wafers, Rolos, Starburst, or TicTacs).

Three first class #10 stamp embossed envelopes from the US Post Office only (No regular stamps, no other size envelopes).

One gallon size bag (No slider bags).

Please do not enclose washcloths, toothbrush holders, floss, or combs!!!


