We will get into the psychology of what an active shooter is and define them. We will also discuss some victims and survivors nationwide and local events that have happened in the past. This will include active shooters in churches in SC and



other locations in the United States. We will go over what to expect during the event and what to expect from responding police officers. We will discuss 'Avoid, Deny and Defend', and what to do in the event you are ever in an active shooter event. We will also discuss the worship environment and what to expect and how to recognize potential suspects. We will discuss building your safety team and how to begin to set up your safety plans. We will meet on Thursday, Feb 23 at First Baptist Church, Lugoff, at 6 pm.
